The CPR skill has been deleted from the procedure list.



Purpose: To provide the Health Science student with an opportunity to develop and demonstrate knowledge and skills in veterinary medical care.

Here is a sample of the event guidelines. It is important to know what the event entails, does the event have a knowledge test, skill event, what are the supplies requires, the dress code, and even how long the event will last. Does it have an elimination round? Notice in the right hand corner the different icons. Below you will find the event icon table.

ICON TABLE

Indicates general requirements. For specific information, see the event guidelines.			
	At the NLC, a Showcase will be offered for this event.		Official notebook, scrapbook or portfolio required.
	Competitors must meet a 70% mastery score on skills in this event.		Round One scores are used to advance competitors to Round Two at the NLC.
	Two paper copies of the event product must be submitted.		Plagiarism or copyright violation is prohibited.
	The orientation includes an event element. Competitors must bring pencils/pens.		A computer is used at the NLC to provide a statistically fair method for balancing scores when multiple sections are scheduled.
	Team event – Minimum and maximum (if greater than 2) number of team members.		Includes a secret topic that may not be discussed or revealed to others until the event has concluded.
